

Beginnergarten Daily Schedule

Free Choice

During free choice time, students are able to play, practice and increase vocabulary, and develop friendship skills/positive interactions with peers.

Daily Meeting

Students gather at the circle time rug to share "good news" with the class, gain confidence in sharing in a group setting, and increase language/vocabulary skills.

Calendar / Whole Group Math

Students practice the days of the week, months of the year, count, and explore the weather and the math concept of the day.

ELA (English Language Arts)

During ELA, the students learn the concepts for reading skills, writing skills, listening, and speaking. We work on phonics, phonemic awareness, pre-reading skills, and literacy skills.

Movement Exercise

Students take a "learning break" to get up and move. This activity could involve a game, movement songs, or a following the leader listening activity.

Social Studies / Science

The students will explore a variety of hands-on science and social studies units. Social studies and science activities are on alternate days depending on the lessons.

Snack

The students will bring in a healthy snack from home each day and will be given the opportunity to engage in appropriate social interaction as they enjoy their snack.

Bible

The students are introduced to Bible truths and Christian character through Bible stories, application stories, Bible verses, and music. These concepts are developed and reinforced throughout the school day.

Recess

When the weather allows, students are given the opportunity to run, play, explore, and develop gross motor skills at the outdoor school playground. Recess will be held indoors in inclement weather.

Centers

Teachers will work with students at their own developmental level in small groups or individually to develop curriculum skills through hands on projects and activities. Centers will include reading, writing, math, science, social studies, and fine motor activities.

Dismissal

Students will be dismissed one by one from the classroom to parents or carpools.

Students will also participate in art, music, physical education, world language, and library classes once each week with special teachers certified in those areas.
