

Dear Parents of Elementary and Kindergarten Students,

Thank you for your interest in Plymouth Christian Academy. More than just a college preparatory school, PCA is a community desiring to produce students **matured** in their love for God, **steeped** in His Word, **educated** about His world, **dedicated** to lives of service and learning, and **prepared** to fulfill their calling in His kingdom. We see our students as “investments for eternity” as we allow God to work through us in the shaping of their lives. As a Christian school, it is our goal to service families with a quality educational program in a Christ-centered environment. The teachers we hire, the curriculum we use, and the special programs we develop, all work together to meet our goal.

Our Christian environment is developed by certified Christian teachers who teach Bible daily in their classes, lead their students in a regular devotional time, and role-model Christian living. The school holds regular chapel programs to challenge the students in the Christian life. Teachers and administration teach subjects and approach discipline from a Biblical perspective.

To fulfill our school goals, there are three major requirements for entrance:

- 1) **CHRISTIAN COMMITMENT/PARENTAL SUPPORT** - Families must embrace the teaching of Christian values and principles in the classroom. We look for families who want their child(ren) to have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and will work with our school in educating their child(ren).
- 2) **ACADEMIC EXPECTATION** (Grades 1-6) - A student must score a minimum percentile score of 40% on the NWEA Measure of Academic Progress (MAP) assessment for the grade to which he/she wants to be admitted. If there is an academic concern, the administrative team will review the data and determine admittance.
- 3) **STUDENT CHARACTER** - We look for students who desire to attend our school and will respect the authority of teachers and the rights of other students.

As always, we encourage you to schedule a time to tour the school or possibly have your child visit a classroom during the school day. Please call to set up an appointment. I trust the enclosed information will help you understand our school and the application process. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact us.
