DAILY SELF SCREENING

Parents, please use this screening tool each day to determine if your student should come to school.

Has your student experienced any of the following in the past 24 hours?

- Fever (temperature greater than 100.4 F)
- Cough (new or worsening)
- Headache AND sore throat
- Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing
- Runny nose and/or congestion
- Body aches and/or tiredness
- Vomiting and/or diarrhea
- New loss of taste and/or smell

If you answered "yes" to any of the above symptoms, we ask that you stay home today. Please consult the Decision Tree for the path to take on deciding when your student can return to school and what will be needed to return.

Has your student had CLOSE CONTACT within the last 14 days with someone recently diagnosed with COVID-19 or traveled out of the US by airplane in the past 14 days? Close contact is defined as being within 6 feet for greater than 15 minutes.

If you answered "yes" to this question, your student must remain at home and quarantine for 14 days since last contact or return to the U.S.
