Position Summary:

The School Nurse and Health Compliance Supervisor reports to the School Superintendent and plays an integral role as an advocate, liaison, and consultant on health-related issues for students, families, and the school community. The School Nurse and Health Compliance Supervisor is responsible for implementing best practice measures to ensure the promotion of health and wellness within the school environment. These responsibilities involve direct student care, health education and policy management. The School Nurse and Health Compliance Supervisor must also adhere to local, state and federal guidelines to ensure compliance of the overall health within the school community.

Education and Experience:

- Bachelor of Science in Nursing or Diploma equivalent required
- Minimum of two years of experience as a school nurse, preferrable in public health nursing
- Valid Registered Nurse (RN) license to practice professionally in Michigan required
- Basic understanding of health appraisal and immunization record collection and management
- Experience relating to, speaking to parents and community

Job Responsibilities:

- Provide communicable disease prevention and control programs
- Offer direct care during the school day to students and faculty/staff
- Manage the medical needs of students with chronic health concerns



- Create and maintain documentation of all treatment and medical service activity performed
- Clearly and effectively communicate with parents, healthcare providers, along with faculty/staff regarding student health concerns while maintaining confidentiality.
- Create, maintain, and implement school health policies
- Educate students, parents, and employees on various health issues
- Provide guidance and counseling around health to students, faculty/staff, and parents according to professional standards
- Identify and report school building safety or environmental issues which impact student or staff health to the building administrator
- Ensure school compliance to local, state, and federal requirements for record keeping and reporting of communicable disease and other health concerns
- Collaborate with the Safety and Security Director to maintain a safe, healthy learning environment
- Participate on the school Health and Safety committee, to develop and implement school wellness plans and procedures
- Maintain inventory of supplies and materials needed
