Position Summary:

Plymouth Christian Academy is seeking a full-time, **Secondary Physical Education Teacher**. The **Secondary P.E. Teacher** uses creative methods to foster a desire for students to learn and grow spiritually, academically, emotionally, and socially. The goal of instruction is to ensure that the students accomplish the objectives established by the school for each grade level. The specific focus is to provide quality instruction to help the students understand the relationship of maintaining a healthy body function and exercise; that motivates each student to cultivate physical fitness and positive health choices. This position also meets with parents during conferences and collaborates with other teachers and administration daily.

- Teach Health Education to promote a healthy lifestyle, behaviors, and positive choices.
- Establish and maintain accurate records on each student.
- Prepare report cards and comments as well as maintain ongoing grade records.

- Provide remediation or enrichment for students, as necessary.
- Teach Physical Education with the Biblical Integration method.
- Plan and participate in field trips.
