

PCA's Curriculum Review Cycle

Each year at PCA, a team of teachers is assembled by the Academic Director for a curriculum study. The purpose of the study is to determine if the current curriculum is effectively supporting student learning or if an update is needed. Teachers do research, complete a SWOT analysis, engage in discussions, analyze data, evaluate multiple samples of curricula, complete rating forms, and recommend top curriculum choices. Then, the PCA leadership team evaluates the recommendations and determines if a new curriculum will be implemented. When new curriculum is implemented, teachers receive training from the publishing company, as well as support from PCA's academic team.
